- c. Commissioner Adleman made a motion to approve Resolution 6351 authoring the City to participate in the Craftsman with Character Program with South Beloit High School and approving a Form Agreement for Prospective Craftsman with Character Volunteers. Commissioner Hedrington second the motion. Administrator Hoppes said the request came from the South Beloit High School. The agreement comes with waivers. Students will intern with the Streets and Sewer Departments. Administrator Hoppes said she will look into adding other departments. Roll call vote showed 5 ayes.
- d. Commissioner Prentice made a motion to approve Resolution 6352 approving an Intergovernmental Agreement between the Illinois State Police for the City of South Beloit to join the Violent Crime Intelligence Task Force. Commissioner Morse second the motion. Roll call vote showed 5 ayes.
