Fall Open Burning Period October 3rd, 2026 – November 15th, 2026

City of South Beloit Fall Open burn period will begin on the first Saturday in October to continue for six weeks ending on Sunday immediately following the sixth week which will be in November. Open burning during this period is allowed from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

The fall open burning period in South Beloit will be October 3rd, 2026, through November 15th, 2026, during the hours of 8:00 am till 6:00 pm.

Residents are allowed to burn yard waste generated on their own property. Burning of treated lumber, trash or furniture is strictly prohibited. Burn site shall not exceed 60 inches in diameter and must be located 30 feet away from any structure.

Fires are not permitted to be left unattended at any point and participants are required to have water or other means of always extinguishing the fire nearby. All open burning must cease upon request of the police or fire department, if the fire has been deemed to have become a health or safety issue. Burning shall be conducted when winds are below 10 m.p.h. to reduce the spread of fire. Smoke shall not impede or obscure roadway visibility.
