

Fall Open Burning Period October 4th, 2025 November 16th, 2025

Pursuant to the City of South Beloit Code of Ordinances, Fall Open Burning Period will begin on the first Saturday in October to continue for six weeks ending on the Sunday immediately following the sixth week. Open burning during this period is allowed from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Residents are allowed to burn yard waste generated on their own property. Burning of treated lumber, trash, or furniture is strictly prohibited. Burn site shall not exceed 60 inches in diameter and must be located 30 feet away from any structure.

Fires are not permitted to be left unattended at any point and participants are required to have water or other means of extinguishing the fire nearby at all times. All open burning must cease upon request of the police or fire department, if the fire has been deemed to have become a health or safety issue. Burning shall be conducted when winds are below ten m.p.h. to reduce the spread of fire. Smoke shall not impede or obscure roadway visibility.
