Persons interested in running for these offices may obtain nomination petitions that can be found on the Illinois State Board of Election's website, www.elections.il.gov or pick up nomination petitions in the South Beloit City Clerk's Office from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday beginning August 25, 2026.

Notice is hereby given that the office of the City Clerk in and for the City of South Beloit will be open November 16, 2026 through November 20, 2026 and on November 23, 2026 during regular business hours Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., for the purpose of accepting candidate petitions for the Consolidated Election to be held on April 6, 2027.
