

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 2842

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SOUTH BELOIT, ILLINOIS AMENDING VARIOUS PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 102 TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE II. STOPPING, STANDING, AND PARKING, IN THE CITY OF SOUTH BELOIT CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the City of South Beloit, Illinois (“City”) has adopted a City Code of Ordinances (“Code”); and

WHEREAS, Chapter 102 Traffic and Vehicles, Article II. Stopping, Standing, and Parking, regulates stopping, standing, and parking; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend various provisions of Article II. Stopping, Standing, and Parking; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined it is in the best interest of the City and its citizens to enact such amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of South Beloit, Illinois as follows:

1. The above recitals are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.
2. Article II. Stopping, Standing, and Parking, Sec. 102-52 – Posting of no parking signs, is hereby amended to read as follows (additions shown as **bold and underlined** and deletions as ~~strikethroughs~~):

“Sec. 102-52 – Posting of no parking signs

- (a) The chief of police or any other person authorized by the mayor and city council shall cause signs to be posted indicating parking is limited or prohibited within the City.
 - (i) Limited parking is odd/even parking and applies to every City street. The City Council, or their designee, shall cause signs to be posted at City entrances and/or where deemed necessary.
 - (ii) Odd/even parking. On even-numbered calendar ~~days~~ **months**, vehicles may be parked on that side of the street ~~where~~ **bearing** even-numbered ~~buildings~~ **addresses.** ~~are or would be located, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. on the following day.~~ On odd-numbered calendar ~~days~~ **months**, vehicles may be parked on that side of the street ~~where~~ **bearing** odd-numbered ~~buildings~~ **addresses.** ~~are or would be located, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. on the following day.~~ **For the purposes of this section, each month shall commence at 8:00 a.m. on the first day of the month.**

- (iii) Signs posted includes, but is not limited to, physically posted signs, notice posted on the City website, or designation in a City Ordinance.
 - (iv) Penalty. The penalty for violating this section shall be \$30.00 for the first offense and \$60.00 for the second offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues. After 20 days if the penalty is not paid, the penalty assessed will double.”
3. All other ordinances of the City shall remain in effect as previously enacted except that those ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
